Donna Mae Baringer, 67, of Napoleon, Ohio passed away on December 2, 2019 at Ebeid Hospice after being diagnosed with Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma in 2000. Donna was very involved in the community; serving as the Mayor of Holgate from 1991 through 1995, as a member of Liberty Chapel United Methodist Church, a board member for Horseback Haven therapeutic riding program, and a board member of the Henry County Humane Society. She also taught Red Cross CPR classes for over 20 years and volunteered for Henry County Hospice. Donna was an advocate for all animals and enjoyed showing Quarter Horses in her younger years. She also like antiques, audio books, and shopping.

Donna is survived by her sister, Kathleen (Lynn) Jones; brother, Dean (Carol) Fahringer and many nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Daniel
